The first round was conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> February 2019. The first round is an online round where all the participating teams are given two cases to which they have to give their best possible solution.

The cases are as below:

#### Case1:

BEAT HARMONY ---- BEAT HARMONY Television is a satellite and cable television channel operating in the international market. The firm is owned by an American company and was launched in 1981 in the American market. Initially, the main content aired by the firm was light popular HARMONY suited to people aged between 18 and 35 years. The firm gradually added more content suited to people of different ages, including children and elders. In 1987, the company started expanding into the global market, starting with Europe. After achieving significant market growth in the European market, the company expanded its operations into the Middle East in 2007. The Arab culture is the biggest challenge that BEAT HARMONY faced when expanding into the Middle East. The Arabic Culture and the Challenges it poses to BEAT HARMONY --- The Arabic culture is unique since it is strongly attached to religion. Although there are a few other religions in the Arabic world, most Arabs follow the Islamic religion. Consequently, most Arabs hold onto strict moral values and norms. People in most of the countries that make up the Arabic world embrace a conservative culture. The components of the Arabic culture, therefore, have significant variations from the components of the western culture. Exposure of most parts of the woman's body is tolerated in the Western culture, but not in the Arabic culture. As such, the Arabic culture is conservative while the Western culture is explicit. Just like in other cultures, the Arabic culture is made up of numerous sub-cultures. For instance, the culture of the people of Saudi Arabia has some differences from the culture of the citizens of the United Arab Emirates and Qatar. Due to the conservative culture that is prevalent in the Arabic nations, most Arabs are likely to perceive such content as being offensive. Further, BEAT HARMONY is faced with the challenge of coping with the different subcultures existing in the Arab world.

#### Case 2:

EMPLOYEE OVER TIME ----- Neon Tech is an IT based service company whose turn-over is 120 crores. It was initially established in Bangalore. The company deals with small establishments which require software that help them to maintain their Web Development, Customer data, keeping record of their Financial Transactions, Infrastructure Establishment, Network Securities and Local Communication Services. Neon Tech has already signed a contract with Surya Engineering Solutions for Web Development Service. The contract was made for 4 crores with the condition to deliver the product by 31st December 2018. The contract was signed on 1st July 2018. The working hours of the employees were 9 hours a day starting from 9am in the morning to 6pm in the evening. Half way through the completion of the project Neon Tech was offered with another much awaiting project in the Government Sector. Getting projects in the Government Sector is one of the major accomplishments for any regional company. But the schedule of the workers may turn cumbersome as the project period for both is alike and the employees need to work overtime in order to meet the deadlines. The latter one cannot be neglected as once a project in the Government is successfully delivered, then the value of the company will be drastically changing, and market may increase. The company is not in position to pay overtime to the employees while the employees are also not ready to work without any incentives. The first contract should not be broken and the latter one should not be denied while the existing employees should work overtime. Neon Tech is facing challenge in coping up with the situation and keep their employees in tact while boosting them to deliver their project in stipulated time. Device a strategy keeping in mind the reputation of the company after the delivery of the Government project.

By the 11<sup>th</sup> February morning submissions were closed and by 13<sup>th</sup> february evening all the responses were studies and a total of 23 teams were shortlisted for the second phase of BCOMBAT.
