



Action Taken Report on Student Feedback

Academic Year(2019-20)

The feedback from the students for the academic year 2019-20 has shown a considerable progress in their perception on a spectrum of parameters which includes their teaching-learning experience, ambience of institution, infrastructural facilities like classrooms, labs, library, sports and recreational facilities, academic and career counselling , hostels etc.,

The students have given an overwhelming positive response on all the parameters. They rated the college as an excellent place for academics and extra-curricular activities. Most of the students felt that they are successfully getting the value of the money they are spending on their education.

Students Suggestions and Action Taken:

01. Sports Facilities: The sports facilities have to be improved.

Action Taken:

The administration encourages students to participate actively in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. It provides all the necessary facilities towards this end. The college has developed an exclusive basket ball court , volley ball court, tennis courts and a play ground. The college is also equipped with indoor sports facilities for table-tennis, caroms, chess etc., The institution has also spent an appreciable amount in developing a well equipped Gym in college, hostels (both boys and girls).

02. Food and Hostel Facilities: The students feel that canteen could be improved.

Further the hostel requires secured locker facility.

Action Taken:

The canteen has been given a complete face lift and the responsibility of its maintenance has been taken up by the management itself. This has considerably improved the quality of food and hygiene. The student's requirement for secured locker facility is well taken care of by the estate administration.

03. Updation of syllabus and add recent technology: A minor section of students feel that the syllabus has to be updated and labs have to be upgraded.

Action Taken:

Since the college has attained autonomous status, it has got the flexibility in introducing new courses and updation of syllabus in line with the present day industrial requirements. The departments have also included skill development courses in their respective curriculums to improve the placement avenues for the students.

The upgradation and removal of obsolescence from the labs is a continuous process. The departments apply for the necessary budget towards this end from the management and the management on its part has continuously supported in this program. The departments also apply for grants under MODROBS scheme to AICTE for purchase of modern equipments which will add value to the labs and improve the learning experience of the students.

04. Hygiene and Maintenance of Washrooms: A general perception of students is that the washrooms across all the departments need regular maintenance.

Action Taken:

The administration has taken up the gigantic task of renovating all the departments last year. This task has been since completed and has given an improved outlook. The washrooms, classrooms have been upgraded. Further, sanitation is given a top priority in the present situation of Pandemic.
